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STEP 1

On a covered surface (e.g., newspaper) lay your sheet of large paper flat, gather the materials listed and print out the stencils and gift tags.

STEP 2 ADULT SUPERVISION! *


Divide your foam board or thick card into smaller finger length squares. An adult will need to help with this as you'll have to use a box cutter or penknife.





Create some shapes! Draw around the stencils onto your foam board or card. Ask for an adults help to cut out the shapes along the lines drawn.





STEP 4


Now you can prepare your stamps! Using a comb, pen, skewers or toothpicks, you can gently scratch and press line marks into your foam or card square. You can do spirals, zigzags, polka dots or wavy lines. The ideas are endless!











STEP 5

Ink your new stamps and shapes using an ink pad! Have fun stamping onto your paper! You can overlap your marks, or stamp your prints side by side. Work until your paper is nicely covered with your patterns then leave it to dry.

STEP 6

When your paper is completely dry, wrap your present and sign the gift tag. Loop the elastic or string through the card and tie around your present. Hooray! You have just made your own wrapping paper!





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
